Practicing Hospitality can help your church learn how to give visitors a warm and generous welcome. The learning module will assist congregations to identify areas for improvement and plan simple changes to make your church more warm and inviting.

In addition to the Biblical examples of hospitality, this experiential learning module helps churches avoid common “welcoming faux pas.” For the purpose of learning, **Practicing Hospitality** considers church worship as planning an event similar to a celebration or party.

Through a series of video vignettes and other exercises church members learn:

- what it takes to be more warm and welcoming
- what it feels like to be a visitor
- how to make the simple changes that will make a big difference

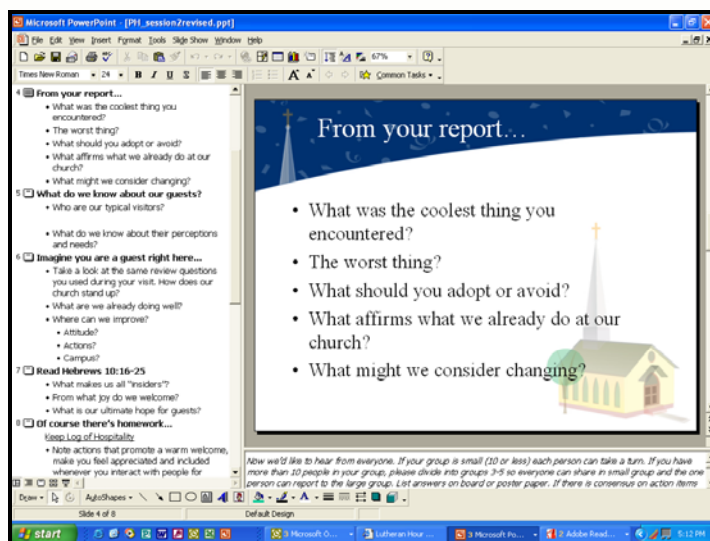

Friendliness is important and often overlooked:

- 32% of church visitors say they will return because of the “friendliness of the church.”
- 38% of new visitors report no follow-up from the church after their first visit.
